Welcome

Thanks for considering Light Bank Holiday Services for your holiday lighting. Light Bank is the seasonal division of TC Polished Windows — the same insured, locally owned team you already trust on ladders around your home. This catalog is built to make it simple — pick a bulb size, pick a spacing, and pick a color pattern. We handle the rest: professional install, storage in the off-season, and takedown in January.

Every install uses commercial-grade bulbs and cords, cut to the exact length of your rooflines. Cords accept both C7 and C9 bulbs, so if you want to change your look next year, you don't need to start from scratch.

Service area: Kennewick, Richland, Pasco, West Richland, Finley, and Benton City.

Install

We hang it — no ladders, no fiddly clips.

Storage

Off-season bulb + cord storage included.

Takedown

January removal is part of every package.

Warranty

If a strand fails, we replace it fast.

Build Your Look — Bulb Size



C7 — Smaller bulb (~1.5")

A refined, more understated look. Great for homes with shorter rooflines, detail runs, or when you want the lights to feel classic and subtle.

C9 — Larger bulb (~2.5")

Bigger, bolder, and more visible from the street. The right choice for larger homes, two-story setups, or if you want a showpiece that stops traffic.

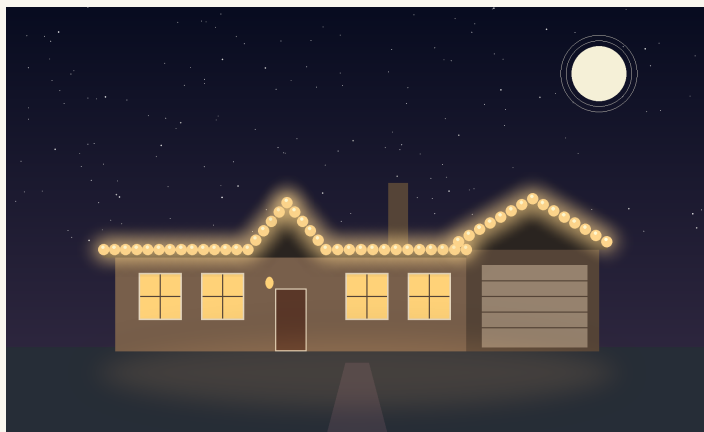
Same cord fits both sizes.

Change from C7 to C9 (or back) in a future season without re-running wire.



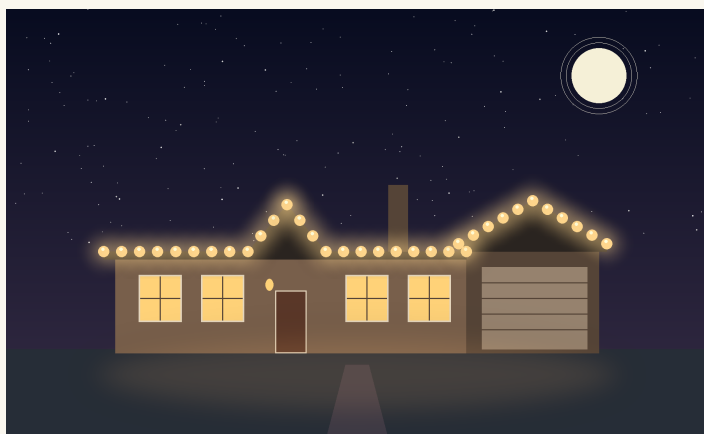
Build Your Look — Bulb Spacing

Spacing controls how dense your lights look. Tighter spacing reads as a continuous ribbon of light; wider spacing reads as distinct bulbs. All three options use the same cord system.



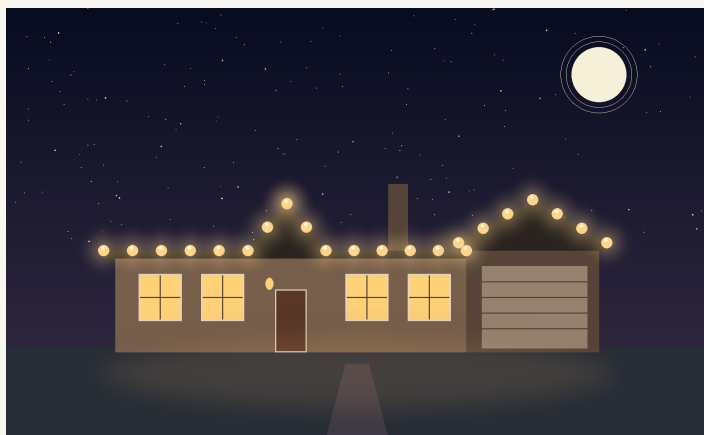
6" spacing

Densest look. Best for C7 bulbs and ornate trims.



9" spacing

The most popular choice. Balanced, classic, works with either bulb.



12" spacing

Airy and bold. Pairs best with C9 bulbs on large rooflines.



How to Use This Catalog

- **1. Pick your bulb size.**
C7 for subtle, C9 for bold. (See page 4.)
- **2. Pick your spacing.**
Tight (6"), balanced (9"), or airy (12"). (See page 5.)
- **3. Pick a pattern.**
Browse the Pattern Gallery and note the configuration you like.
- **4. Call or text us.**
We'll measure your home, confirm footage, and send a quote.
- **5. We install, store, and take down.**
You get the photo-worthy home with none of the ladder work.

Pro tip from the TC Polished Windows crew

Our wind can be real. If your home is on a ridgeline or faces the Columbia, we recommend 9" or 12" spacing with C9 bulbs — the weight and spacing keep the strand from flapping on windy nights.

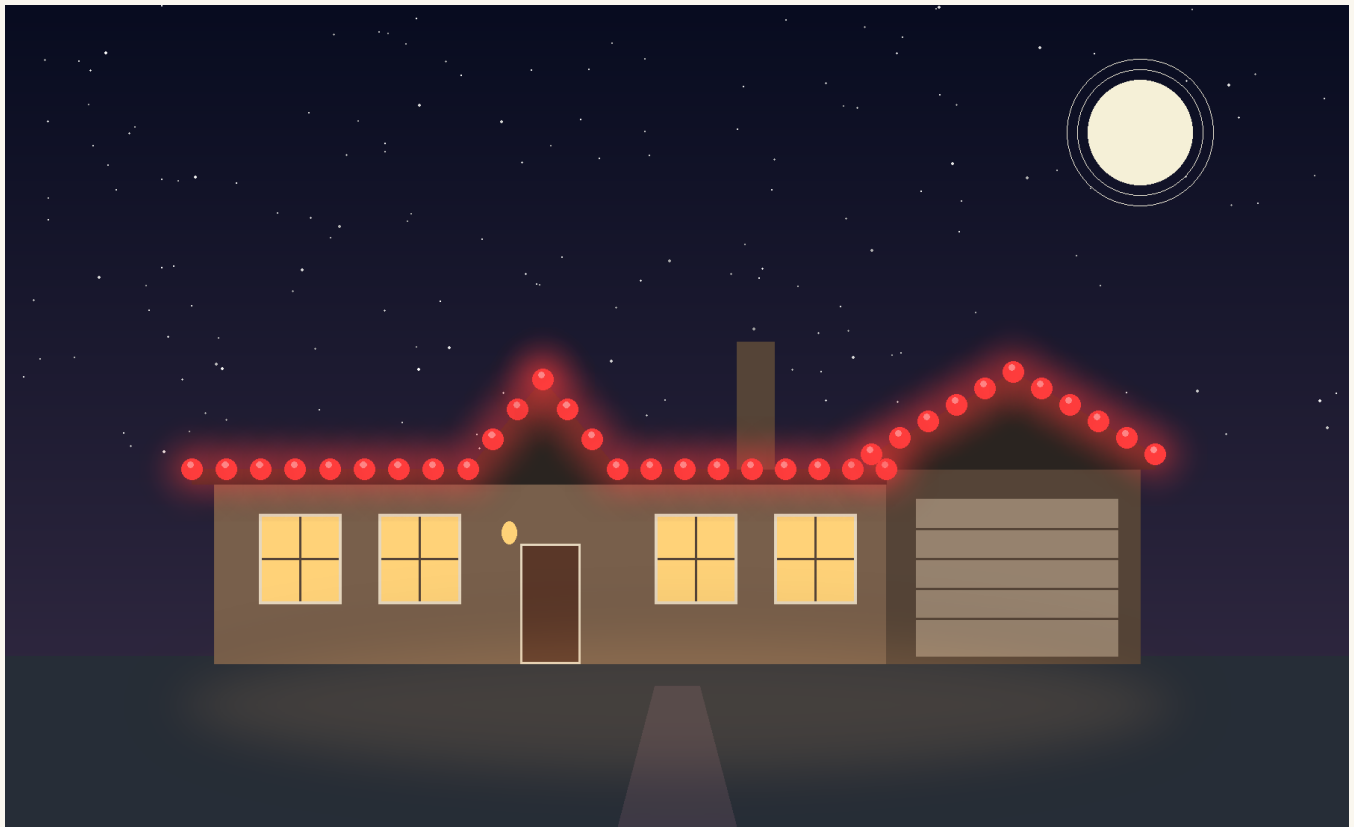

Solid Blue

All-blue bulbs create a cool, icy feel. Reads beautifully on white or gray homes and holds up well from the street.

Alternating, 2-and-2, and 3-and-3 configurations



Red & Green (1:1)

Every-Other Alternating



About this configuration

Red and green alternating bulb-by-bulb. The quintessential Christmas configuration — lively and instantly festive.

About this configuration

Warm White & Red (1:1)

Every-Other Alternating



About this configuration

Warm white and red alternating. Softer than solid red — the red accents pop while the warm white keeps the overall feel elegant.

Red & Green (2:2)

Two-and-Two Blocks



About this configuration

Two red bulbs, then two green, repeating. More rhythm than 1:1 alternating — the pattern is clearly readable from the curb.

Warm White & Blue (2:2)

About this configuration

Two warm white, then two blue. A gentle contrast that pairs perfectly with blue or gray exteriors — a newer favorite.

Red & Green (3:3)

Three-and-Three Blocks



About this configuration

Three red bulbs, then three green. Longer color runs read almost like ribbons of color — especially striking on long, straight rooflines.

The traditional strand: red, yellow, blue, green, orange repeating. Nostalgic, cheerful, and loved by kids. Best with C9 bulbs for that vintage feel.

Warm-white bulbs with a subtle random twinkle. The effect is gentle and cinematic — like candlelight flickering across the roofline. Requires a twinkle-capable strand.

About this configuration

Blue and pure white in two-and-two blocks. Reads icy, fresh, and modern — especially striking against dark siding.

C7 or C9 bulbs · 6" / 9" / 12" spacing



Frequently Asked Questions

How much does it cost?

Every install is priced individually — we don't do flat packages. Pricing depends on your roofline footage, bulb size and spacing, and which configuration you pick. Reach out and we'll come measure your home and send a free written quote.

When do you install?

We start the first week of October and book through mid-December. Your lights stay dark until you tell us to flip the timer on.

When do you take them down?

Takedowns run from the second week of January through early February. We store your bulbs and cords for you in the off-season at no extra charge.

Can I change colors from year to year?

Yes. Your cord and clips stay; we just swap the bulbs. Because our cords fit both C7 and C9, you can even switch bulb sizes in a future season.

What if a bulb or strand fails mid-season?

Message us — we come out and fix it. A warranty mid-season service call is included on every package.

Do you do commercial properties?

Yes. HOAs, office parks, restaurants, and retail storefronts. Ask for a site walk.

What about Tri-Cities wind?

Every strand is clipped (not stapled) to the roofline using commercial clips rated for our wind load. We also tie off transitions so nothing flaps.

Do I have to be home for the install?

No. We just need access to an outdoor outlet and a way for us to reach the roofline. We'll text before and after.

How do I pay?

A 50% deposit books your slot. The balance is due on install day. We accept card, ACH, check, and Venmo.
